### Course Descriptions

#### **Living on the Faultline:**

This locally developed course provides background information on our local earthquake and tsunami hazards, and identifies what to do before, during, and after these disasters to stay safe, reduce injuries, and minimize damage.

#### **Fulfilling Our Mission:**

This prerequisite course introduces potential disaster volunteers and members of other local agencies to the role of the Red Cross in the community's actions in preparing for, responding to and recovering from emergencies and disasters. The course will enable individual volunteers to translate their care and compassion for their community into action and provide information to other community agencies on Red Cross work and possible partnership in preparation for and response to a disaster.

#### **NEW Volunteer Orientation:**

This brief presentation introduces potential volunteers to the opportunities the Red Cross has available to anyone interested in Disaster Services, Disaster Preparedness, CPR & First Aid, Water Safety, or office administration. Come be a part in the community's actions in preparing for, responding to and recovering from emergencies and disasters.
